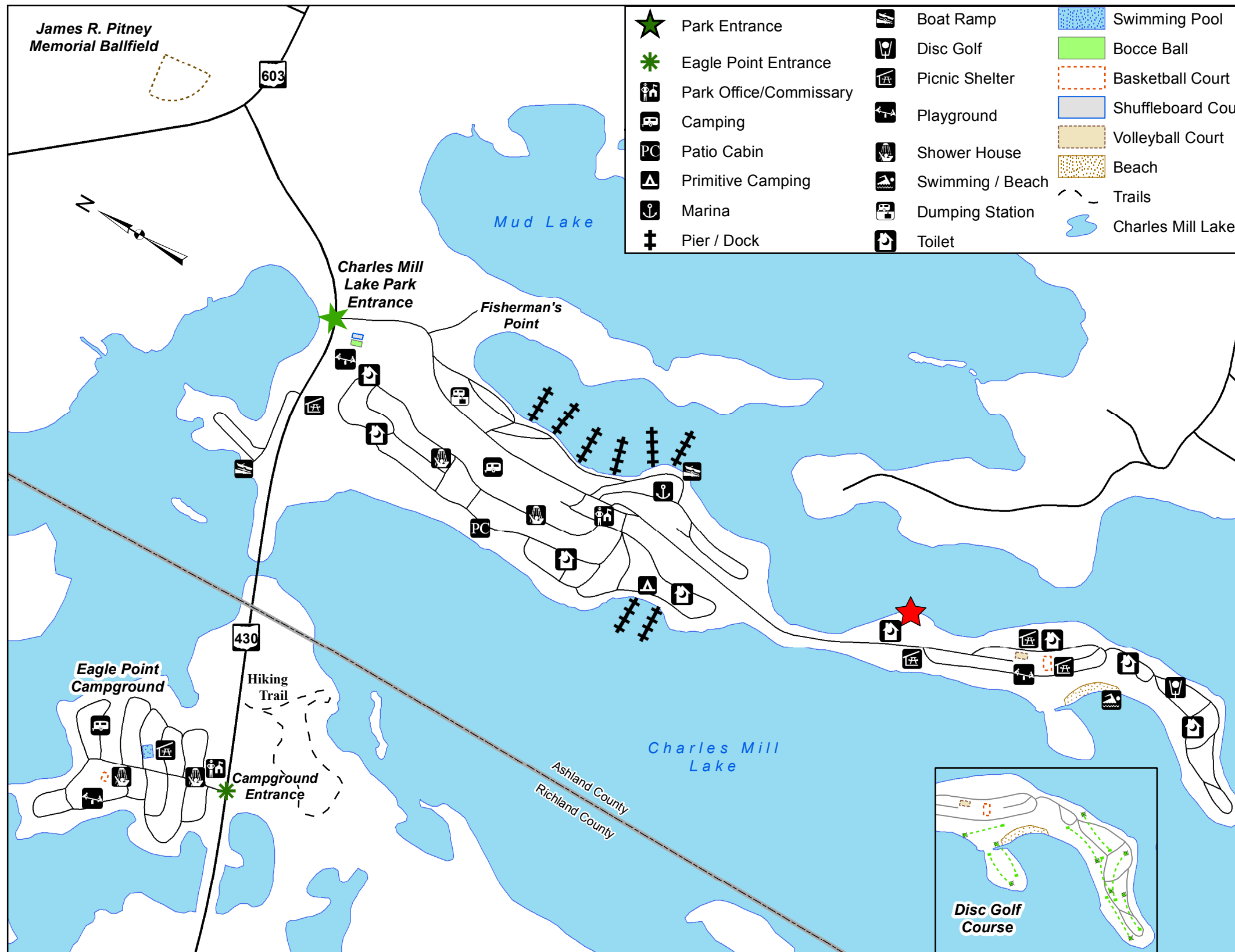


CHARLES MILL Lake

Location: 1277A State Route 430
Mansfield, OH 44903
Charles Mill Lake is located in Richland and Ashland counties, near Mansfield, Ohio. The lake is easily accessed by I-71 or U.S. 30 to St. Rts. 603 and 430.

History: Charles Mill Dam was constructed in 1935 on the Black Fork Creek for the purpose of flood control. The Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD) owns the lake and surrounding land, and is responsible for managing conservation and recreational activities. The dam is owned and operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Hunting: Hunting and trapping on MWCD lands is regulated by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife, which issues a publication detailing Ohio hunting and trapping regulations. To receive this publication, please contact the Division of Wildlife or pick one up at the MWCD main office in New Philadelphia. In the interest of safety, hunting on MWCD land is prohibited within 500 feet of "restricted use" areas, buildings and public roads.

Licenses: State licenses are required by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for fishing, boating, and hunting.

Boat Launching: Public boat launch ramps located near Charles Mill Marina and off St. Rt. 430.
