

Charles Mill Lake is located in Richland and Ashland counties, near Mansfield, Ohio. The lake is easily accessed by I-71 or U.S. 30 to

istory: Charles Mill Dam was constructed in 1935 on the Black Fork Creek for the purpose of

flood control. The Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD) owns the lake and surrounding land, and is responsible for managing conservation and recreational activities. The dam is owned and operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

office in New Philadelphia.

In the interest of safety, hunting on MWCD land is prohibited within 500 feet of "restricted use" areas, buildings and public

roads.

Licenses: State licenses are required by the Ohio

Department of Natural Resources for fishing, boating, and hunting.
