CAMP:

- At Morgan's Riverside Campground (Gilmour Rd., Off St Rt. 123), Fri & Sat

night. (1-800-932-2663).

- Take exit 32 off I-71. From the north, turn left (east). From the south, turn right (east). Follow St RT 123, about 2 miles, watch for Morgan's sign. Turn left onto Gilmour Rd. Campsite is on the left at the bottom of the hill along the river. Watch for OHCRA signs. Sites #13 & #15 have been reserved with #10 & #12 available if needed.

COST:

Camping costs are expected to be \$ 7.50/person/night (nice campground on river with clean showers/restrooms, snack bar, shelter available, etc.).
 Canoe rental is available from Morgan's Canoe Rental. They should provide shuttle to match our trip or we will shuttle. Let Ted know if you're renting, so that arrangements can be made.

- 0900, begin shuttle for a planned ~13 mile trip from Corwin Canoe Access to the campsite. This canoe access is relatively new and is at the small bridge upstream from SR 73 in the middle of Corwin. We have used this access before. Shuttle for shorter trips are available.

 We will have our potluck, group meal around 6 pm. Everyone should bring a dish to share. I expect to deep fry something????.

SUN:

SAT:

 0900, begin shuttle. We plan to start canoeing from our campground and go to either Halls Creek Canoe Access (~6 mi) or to South Lebanon (~10 mi).

OTHER:

- Bring your bike and do any portion of the Little Miami Trail you desire.
   40(+) miles are available from the campsite.
- Hike/bike from campsite to Fort Ancient or a shuttle can be arranged.
- A "topo" map covering ~27miles of the river is available from Ted.
